THE MINISTER OF COMMUNICATION AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY,

DECIDES:

To proclaim : AMENDMENT TO THE DECREE OF THE MINISTER OF COMMUNICATION NUMBER KM.40 OF 2002 ON TERMS OF IMPLEMENTATION DIRECTIVES OF TARIFF ON NON TAX STATE REVENUES FROM OPERATION FEE OF RADIO FREQUENCY SPECTRUM

Article I

To add 3 (three) types of frequency use in Appendix I to the Decree of the Minister of Communication Number KM.40 of 2002 on Implementation Directives of Tariff on non tax state revenues from Operation Fee of Radio Frequency Spectrum, together with Bandwidth Index (Ib) and Transmission Capacity Index (Ip), as follows:
